

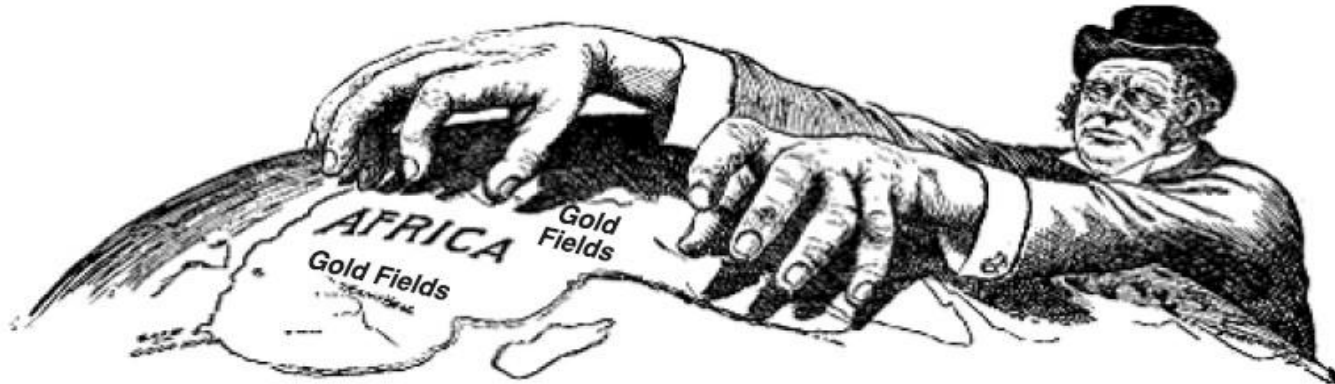

What did the Europeans hope to gain?

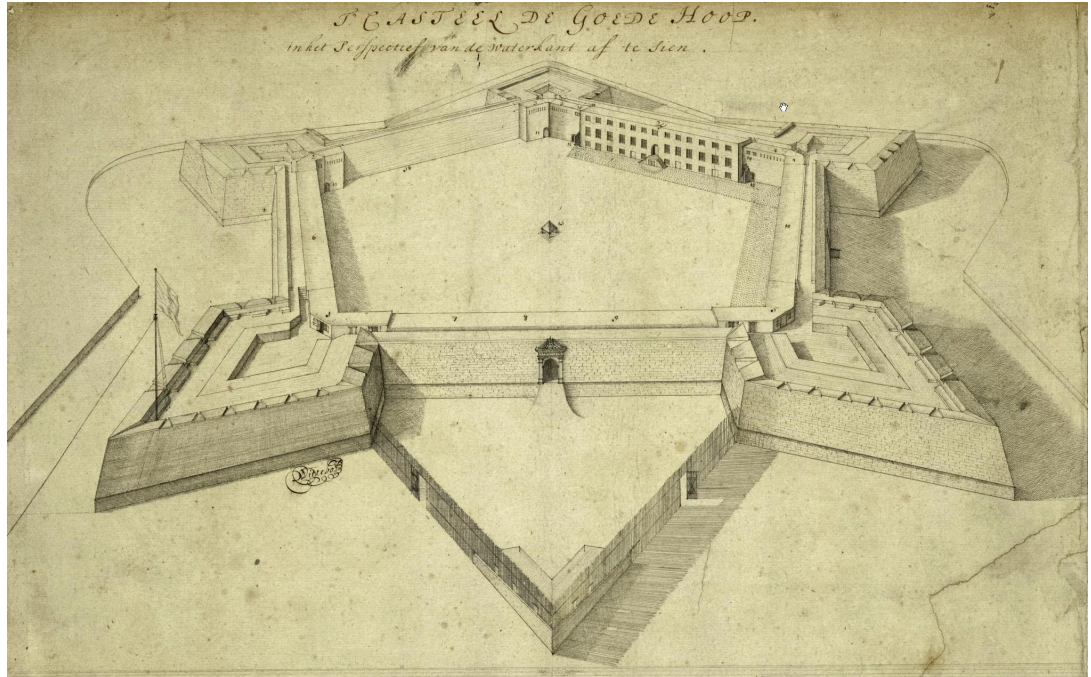


Power

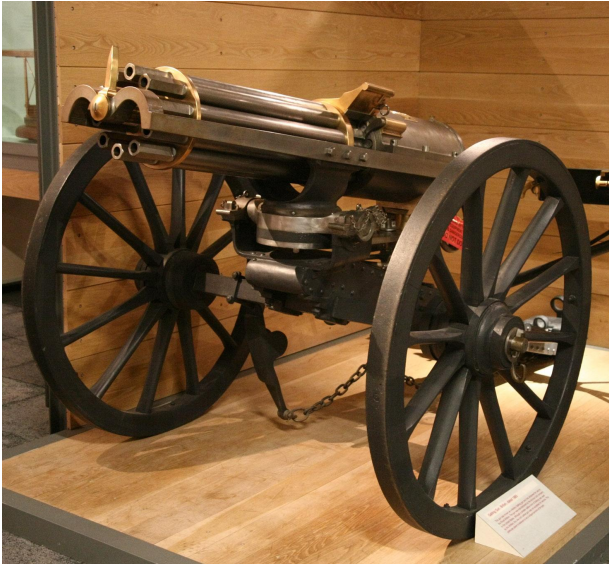
Military Gains

The Cape of Good Hope is one example.

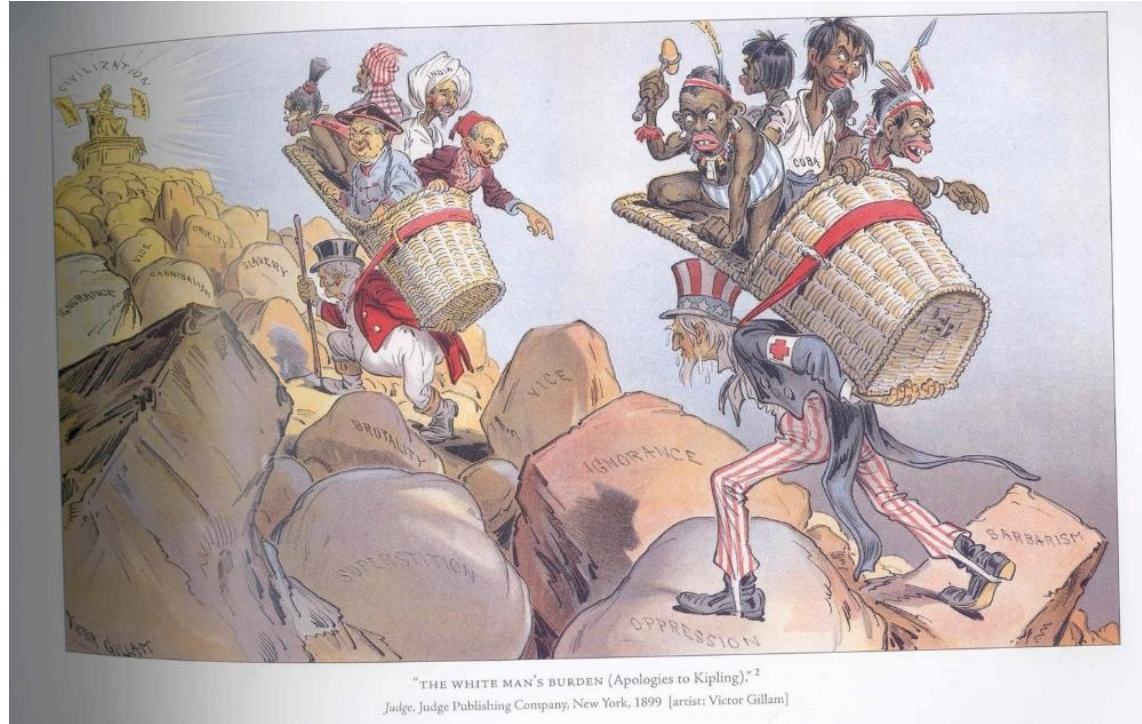


What helped the Europeans?

British Claims

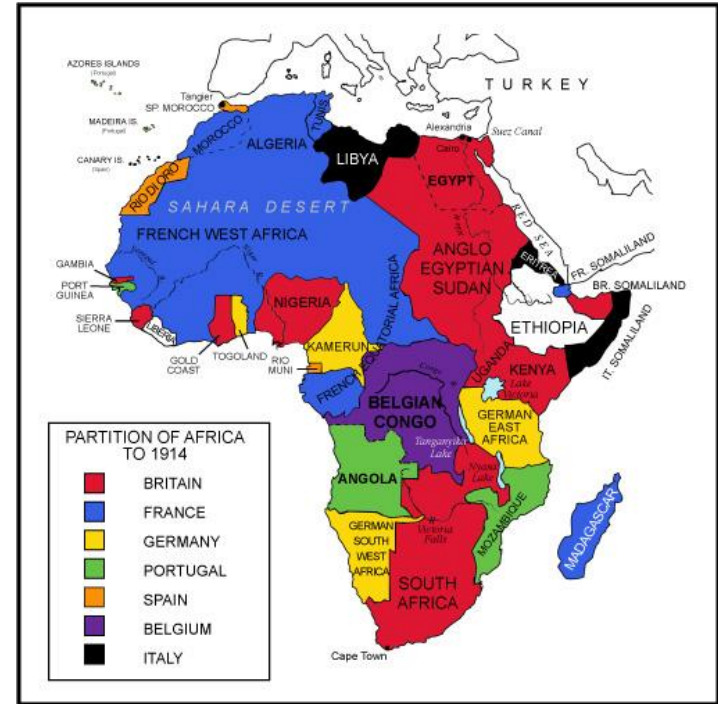

How power was divided

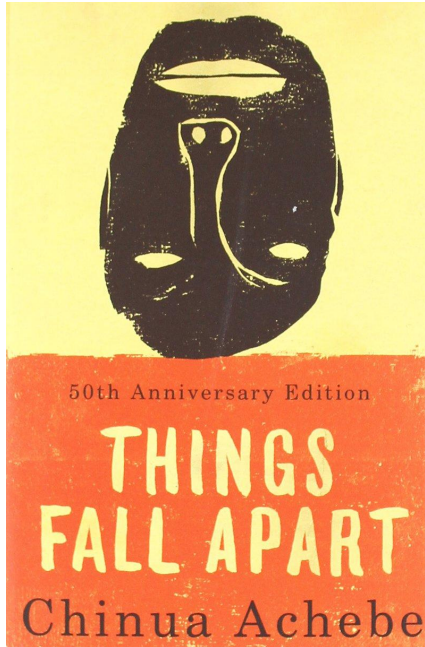
- Berlin Conference
