

Digital Presentation

Purpose:

- To share information and raise awareness of gender issues
- To practice collaboration and communication skills

Task: When your group completes the research of your country and a gender issue, the final part of the project is to collect, organize, and publish your learning and writing as a digital presentation.

This task requires the group:

- to collaborate in the creation of digital presentation.
- to analyze and synthesize the information
- To arrange the information in an organized and interesting format

Guidelines: The digital presentation must have the following:

- A title that includes both the country and the gender issue
- A map which shows your country's location in the world.
- An accurate description the country (can be written or an oral recording)
- A complete description of the gender issue and how it impacts the country (can be written or an oral recording)
- At least 3 statistics about gender issues in your country. All statistics must be properly cited.
- At least 3 images or videos (with citations or URLs) that accurately illustrate gender issues in your country. All images need an accurate description and a clear link to the rest of the presentation
- 3 different types of writings (analytical paragraph, reflective piece, and creative piece) done in English class, at least one from each student (these can be printed words or spoken recordings)

Possible on-line tools: -If you are not doing a Google Site Webpage, you need to share the link to your digital presentation so they can be included in the class webpage.
