- 7. Is fear of punishment for speaking out enough to absolve people of guilt?
- 8. Why didn't the Allies act to save the Jews?
- 9. Does social media and technology make another genocide more or less likely?
- 10. Where does hate come from? How did Hitler turn fears into hatred? Does this happen today?
- 11. Does the Holocaust still shape the world today?
- 12. If you are a soldier and ordered to do something morally wrong, what would you do?
