The Question: Who was the better leader: Napoleon or the leader you researched?

Details:

- Length: 4 pages (Just to be clear, 3 ½ is less than 4)
- It must be typed and shared in your WH2 folder (Use the word “leader” in the title of the document.)
- You must also create a works cited list. In other words, documentation of the sources you used. This must also be typed and shared in your WH2 folder. (Title the document, “Leader Works Cited”.)

Writing is collaborative. Even great writers have editors who assist them. As you write, you will receive feedback and comments from me. The feedback you receive prior to the due date has no grade attached; it is meant to improve the final product. Use of the feedback to make the final copy of the highest quality.

How to structure the paper:

- Introductory paragraph
- Background information of Napoleon and your leader
 - probably 2 paragraphs, each dealing with their early life and rise to power
- Body paragraphs focused on at least **3 different leadership traits**
 - **topic sentence (the trait)**
 - **evidence of the trait in each leader**
 - **analysis of the evidence**
 - **judgment as to which leader better demonstrated the trait**
- Concluding paragraph
 - includes a significance (thesis extension) or connection
